<u>Mission Statement</u>: Demonstrating the role of God and the Bible in the establishment of the United States of America and how our American and Christian heritage is intertwined.

**Lesson One**: The United States of America was founded on Biblical principles:

- 1492 Christopher Columbus's real reason for sailing west from Spain, writings from his own diary, written in 1502.
- 1620 The Pilgrims and the Mayflower Compact, America's first self-government document.
- 1740-1760 The first Great Awakening and how it impacted some of our key Founders.
- 1776 The Declaration of Independence paving the way for the U.S. Constitution both documents are based on Biblical principles.
