Our Lady of Perpetual Help (also known as Our Lady of Perpetual Succour) is a Roman Catholic title of the Blessed Virgin Mary as represented in a celebrated 15th-century Byzantine icon also associated with the same Marian apparition.

The <u>icon</u> originated from the <u>Keras Kardiotissas</u> <u>Monastery</u> and has been in <u>Rome</u> since 1499. Today it is permanently enshrined in the <u>Church of Saint Alphonsus</u>, where the official <u>Novena to Our Mother of Perpetual Help</u> text is prayed weekly.

On 23 June 1867, <u>Pope Pius IX</u> granted the image its <u>Canonical Coronation</u> along with its present title. The <u>Redemptorist Congregation</u> of priest and brothers they are the only religious order currently entrusted by the <u>Holy See</u> to protect and propagate a Marian religious work of art. In the <u>Eastern Orthodox Church iconography</u>, the image is known as the "Virgin <u>Theotokos</u> of the Passion" due to the instruments of the <u>Passion of Jesus Christ</u> present on the image.

The feast day of the image is celebrated on June 27, with novena devotions held every Wednesday. Under <u>Pope Pius XII</u>'s Pontificate, the image was designated as the national <u>Patroness</u> of the <u>Republic of Haiti</u> and <u>Almoradi</u>, Spain. In addition, <u>Pope John Paul II</u> issued a <u>canonical coronation</u> for a similar image in <u>Jaworzno</u>, <u>Poland</u> in 16 June 1999

Due to the propagation of the <u>Redemptorist</u> Priests since 1865, the image has become very popular among Roman Catholics. Modern reproductions are oftentimes displayed in residential homes, commercial establishments, and public transportation.
