It has been a long-standing tradition of the Church to accept requests for your intentions of the living or deceased at regularly scheduled Masses in return for a \$5 offering called a stipend. Now that we have a regular schedule of weekday and Sunday Masses again, our calendar is open to receive any intentions that you might wish to request. Our openings at this time are for Sunday, Tuesday or Wednesday Masses. On Sunday one of the Masses must be offered for the People of the Parish so only one request can be honored that day.

CANDLEMAS DAY—FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD—TUES, FEB. 2 On this day we celebrate the day Mary and Joseph presented

On this day we celebrate the day Mary and Joseph presented the new-born Christ Child in the Temple in accordance with the dictates in the Law of Moses, forty days after his birth. There they met the prophets Simeon and Anna for whom Temple worship was part of their everyday lives. This is also the day the Church traditionally blesses candles for use throughout the coming year. The liturgy this day will begin with a blessing of candles near the entrance of the church and procession into church for Mass. All should gather there before 12:10 p.m. Simeon recognized Jesus as the Messiah and declared him a "light for revelation to the Gentiles." Hence the name "Candlemas," or Mass for (Blessing) Candles.

MEMORIAL OF ST. BLAISE, BISHOP AND MARTYR—WEDNESDAY, FEB. 3

This is the traditional day for blessing of throats because legend has passed down that St. Blaise cured a young boy who was choking on a fish bone. This blessing is an acknowledgment and a grace for the perennial struggle against illness in all forms in the life of the Christian. This blessing will be given at the 7:00 p.m. Mass after the Prayer of the Faithful.
