TOGETHER IN LOVE

There is nothing in the world like knowing that you are loved. True love is more than a feeling. It is a reflection of God's life and grace within us. Real love seeks what is best for the other. It is selfless and sacred. Love is our vocation — the way of life to which each of us is called. "In the beginning," God created man and woman to share in His love. Married couples join in and witness to God's love through the way they live so that their family and friends, coworkers, neighbors and those they serve may see God's love in action.

THE VOCATION OF MARRIAGE

In the vocation of marriage, a man and a woman commit themselves to one another, "in good times and in bad, in sickness and in health." This union is, by its very nature, permanent, faithful and open to children. As Catholics, we understand marriage to be a sacrament — an instrument and sign of God's grace. When a man and a woman enter into this covenant of marriage, they receive a sacrament where "authentic married love is caught up into divine love" (Gaudium et Spes, 48). They receive the sacramental grace to "help one another to attain holiness in their married life and in welcoming and educating their children" (Lumen Gentium, 11).
