Who is best to invite to this specific event?

- Anyone in their teens and older.
- Those who have fallen away from the practice of the Catholic faith or rarely attend church
- Those who are not currently practicing any faith regardless of religious background
- Those with no formal religious background or practice of the faith

Those who this event is not specifically targeted for:

- Catholics who are actively practicing the faith and attending Mass weekly (this is not continuing education for practicing Catholics)
- Lifelong members of Protestant Churches that have a strong faith already and are currently attending another church (this event will not focus on Catholics/Protestants differences)

Helpful advice:

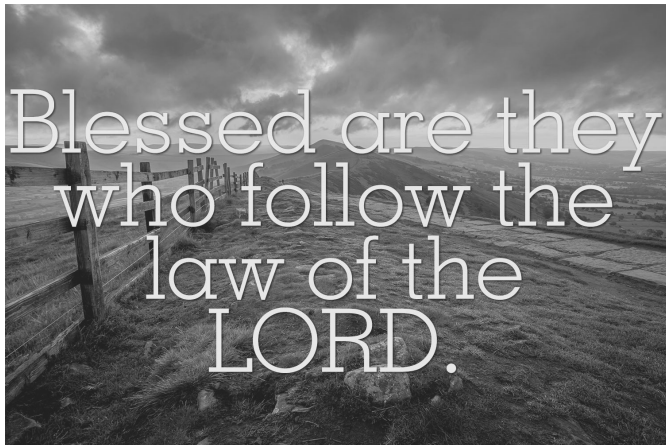

**Effective February 1, 2023**—Due to the number of requests for Mass Intentions and an attempt to be fair to all, we are putting a limit of 12 requests a year per family within the Family of Parishes. The Archdiocese only allows us to schedule a year in advance. If we are over a year, we are required to send the surplus to the Chancery or Mission Office for distribution within the Archdiocese. At this time, St. Patrick is scheduled out through December and St. Mary of the Woods is scheduled out through July.
