Ash Wednesday, February 22nd, and Good Friday, April 7th, are days of abstinence from meat and also days of fast, that is, limited to a single full meal. The other Fridays of the season of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years and older. The law of fasting binds all Catholics from their 18th birthday until their 59th birthday.

St. Mary of the Woods is in need of those willing to serve by taking Communion to the homebound.

Distributors to the homebound are on a monthly, rotating schedule, and are asked to visit once a week during their month. The day of the week is left to the the choice of the distributor.

Training is required. Please contact the office if you are interested in this important work of mercy!

New Translation of the Words of Absolution

The Church has updated the English translation of the Order of Penance, which gives us the prayers for the sacrament of Confession. There are two small changes to the words of absolution. The new words are as follows:

God, the Father of mercies, through the Death and Resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and poured out the Holy Spirit for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God grant you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

The new wording can begin as early as Ash Wednesday (February 22, 2023) and must be used by Divine Mercy Sunday (April 16, 2023). In the Mary, Queen of Angels Family of Parishes we will start using the new translation on February 22.

I think it is appropriate at this time to reflect on the power of the words of absolution. They literally free a person from bondage to sin and from the authority of Satan (which sin places us under) and restore a person to grace. When a priest speaks these words, it is Christ who speaks through the priest to forgive our sins. I encourage all of us to approach the sacrament of Confession this Lent with a renewed appreciation for this incredible gift to the Church!
