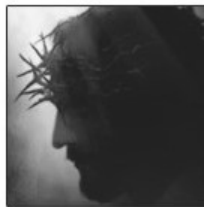

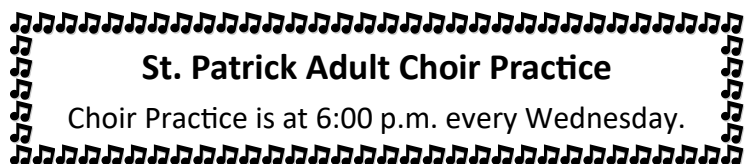

Beacons of Light Update

We are approximately 9 months into the implementation of Beacons of Light. The first challenge in implementation was scheduling—we had to figure out a way for the priests to cover daily Masses, weekend Masses, confessions, office hours, and other commitments across multiple churches, three offices and two counties. We have tried to avoid an excessive amount of driving time and to limit the number of nights the priests spend ‘on the road’ switching between rectories.

The second focus was developing a new leadership structure that will be effective for our family of parishes. After multiple parish council meetings and several town hall meetings, we decided to form two Parish Councils to replace the six previous councils. We now have a Logan County Parish Council and a Champaign County Parish Council. Two councils provide a balance between meaningful representation for each church while still being manageable for the pastor.

The next phase in Beacons of Light is to create a common vision for the future. What are our goals for the future for our family of parishes? This planning will include feedback from staff, Parish Councils, and Finance Councils. We will look at principles such as the centrality of the Eucharist, evangelization, and love in action in forming our vision.

This is a very challenging time for our priests as we implement our families of parishes, and I appreciate the prayers, support and kindness of so many of our parishioners. The food some of the ladies from the parish have prepared has been a life-saver! Please keep all of our priests and parishes in your prayers as we continue through this process.
