## **Foot Washing**

The foot washing on Holy Thursday may seem somewhat anachronistic. The church has kept it in the liturgy for good reason. As Christ washed the feet of his disciples at the Last Supper, emphasizing for them the connection between Eucharist and service to others, this ritual remains in our liturgy for the same reason. It is to emphasize that Eucharist is not separate from service, but that they are inextricably bound together. Part of the nature of receiving Holy Communion is acknowledging that we are intimately connected to one another and responsible for one another's well-being. The essential nature of Holy Communion is unity, not only with God, but also with one another. This is to be demonstrated through service.
