2. You can make St. Mary of the Woods or St. Patrick a beneficiary on your IRA or 401k account, which may reduce estate taxes.
3. For those at least 70-1/2, you can make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from your IRA. You can also use the QCD to comply with your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), which begins at age 73.

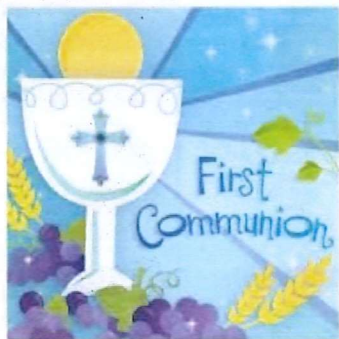


**MONDAY EVENING ROSARY

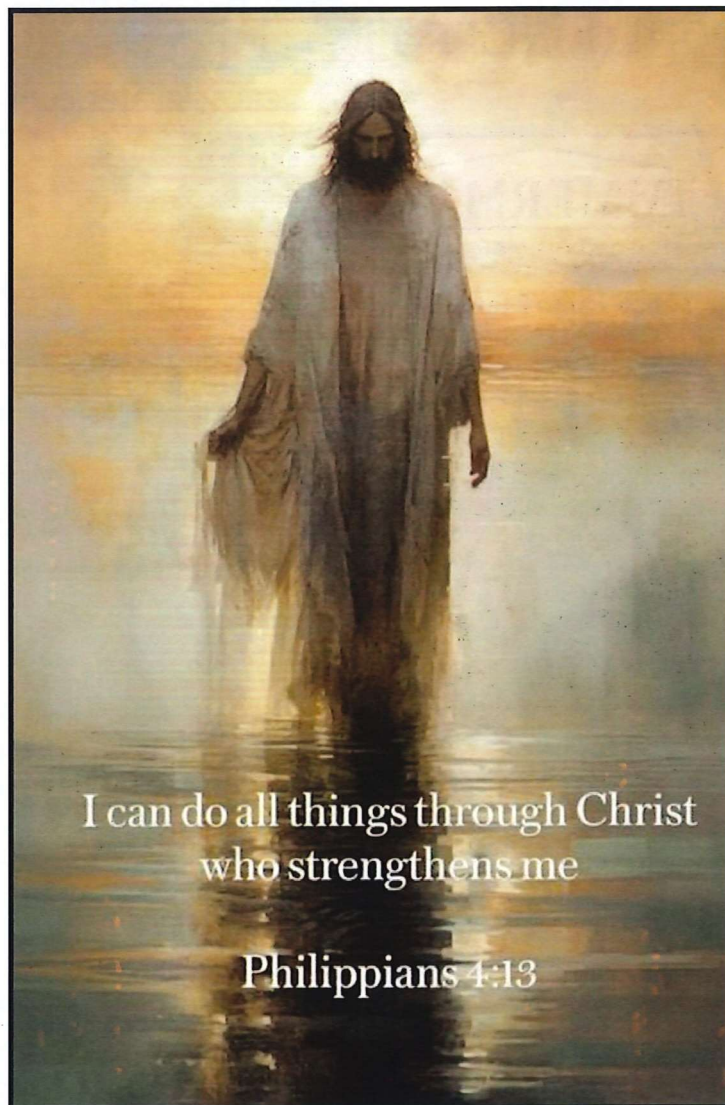
