WEEKEND MASS ATTENDANCE: 332 Funeral Liturgies

Funerals give the opportunity to remember and pray for the deceased and to support and console the bereaved. A distinction is commonly drawn between a funeral Mass (with the body of the deceased present) and a memorial Mass (with no body present, although the cremains—cremated remains—of the deceased may be). Both are liturgies of the church and follow the usual liturgical protocols. If the cremains are present, the cremains may be sprinkled with holy water and incensed at the appropriate times, conferring the same respect normally given to the body of the deceased. However no pall is used. The cremains are usually placed on a table near the paschal candle in the location a casket would occupy during a funeral liturgy. In the case of a memorial Mass without cremains, a picture can be placed in front to give the focal point that the casket would normally provide.
