Hello everyone! My name is Gabriel Salmonowicz. I am a rising sophomore at Franciscan University of Steubenville studying psychology in a 4+1 program to also pursue my master's in counseling. My family have been members of Saint Mary of the Woods since I was born, and we have attended St. Mary of the Woods, St. Patrick's, and St. Mary's in Urbana.

This summer I am blessed to be able to serve with Damascus Missions. Damascus runs Catholic Youth Summer Camp, a camp for middle and high schoolers located in Centerburg, Ohio. The goal of the camp is to counteract the large movement away from the Church that is so prevalent today and to show kids that life with Christ is not boring, it's an adventure. Sadly, 5 in 6 Catholics will leave the Church within 10 years of being confirmed. That is devastating. But here's the good news; 89% of the people who stay in the church through college said that it was because they had an **encounter** with Christ where they came to know Him personally. Damascus seeks to bring that encounter to the teens of America, to fill the need for Christ. They do this by providing an environment of adventure, activities, and community all centered around Christ.

In going on mission with Damascus, I am giving to the Church by serving. I am blessed and beyond excited to have this opportunity. However, I am only able to go if others choose to go with me.
