## **Ministers at Funerals**

It feels good to be able to involve family and friends in the action of the funeral liturgy. If they are trained in the various ministries it can be a natural match. If children are trained as altar servers, they may be able to participate in that role. Many parishes require that the parish musicians provide the music. However, a musician among family and friends may be permitted to work with the parish musicians to contribute their talents. Commissioned extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion among family members may be chosen to serve. Trained readers may assist with the readings. It is very important that they be trained. Frequently when family members are chosen to read, but do not have the proper training or experience, the word of God is lost, since they do not have the ability to proclaim it for the edification of the assembly. Other, non-speaking roles can be given to family members or children such as bringing up the gifts of bread and wine at the presentation of the gifts. Or they might, if the presider permits, be able to assist with the placing of the pall on the casket. Some presiders allow the family members to sprinkle the casket with holy water when it leaves the church building.
