# Vigil or Rosary

The vigil the night or afternoon before the funeral used to be called the rosary. Mostly it consisted of the recitation of the rosary with a few words spoken by a presider and perhaps by some others. Since Vatican II the prescribed vigil is a Liturgy of the Word. It follows the same format as that part of the eucharistic liturgy, including the music. The eulogy used to be given at the funeral Mass, but is now recommended to be part of the vigil service. Since it is not a Mass, the timing can be a little more flexible to allow for this type of sharing by those who wish to speak.
