# The Lamb of God

The Lamb of God is located right above the tabernacle on the high altar. Jesus is the lamb of God because He is the perfect sacrifice to God, dying on the cross for our sins. We can see that a lamb was sacrificed in the book of Exodus when the angel of death was to come over Egypt and kill the first born of those who did not follow the instruction Moses gave to the people. Also, in Isaiah 53:7 is the prophecy of Jesus' death, being led like a lamb for the slaughter. The book with the seven seals that the lamb lays upon represents the seven seals of God that are in the book of Revelation. Jesus, the lamb of God, is worthy of opening these seven seals. The book of Revelation goes into detail what happens as each seal is open, but more importantly represent the second coming of Christ. The flag symbolizes Jesus Christ's victory over death by His death on the cross.
