WEEKEND MASS ATTENDANCE:

Relics

In the Catholic vocabulary relics are the remains of the saints. We venerate them, not in themselves, but in honor of the holy people whom they represent, and in acknowledgement of the good work God has done through them. There are three classes of relics. First class relics are actual bits of bone or hair from the saint. Second class relics are items that belonged to the person, such as clothing, devotional items, etc. Third class relics are items that have touched the first class relics. We venerate these as sacramentals. We do not credit them with miraculous power, but honor God as responsible for any miracles or good works done by the saint, or through use of the relic. We acknowledge that God alone has the miraculous power.
