We will be visiting the National Shrine of Our Lady, Help of Christians at Holy Hill (near Milwaukee), and the only Marian apparition site in the United States to have received Church approval to date--Our Lady of Good Help (near Green Bay). All are welcome!

The tentative schedule is as follows:

Thursday, October 7: depart at 1:00 PM. Stop at the Shrine of Christ's Passion in St. John, IN. <a href="www.shrineofchristspassion.org">www.shrineofchristspassion.org</a>
This shrine has very moving, almost life-sized outdoor Stations of the Cross. Overnight in Milwaukee.

Friday, October 8: The National Shrine of Our Lady Help of Christians at Holy Hill. https://www.holyhill.com/

We will attend Mass, and have some time to explore before heading to Green Bay. Overnight in Green Bay.

Saturday, October 9: The National Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help. https://championshrine.org/

We will attend Mass on the anniversary of the apparition, as well as take a shift in an all-night prayer vigil (Friday to Saturday) commemorating the 150th anniversary of the shrine's miraculous preservation from the most devastating fire in US history.

We will return late in the evening on October 9.

My name is Heather Robison and I am the Transportation Community Liaison for Catholic Social Services of the Miami Valley. I wanted to reach out to you regarding a pilot program we hope to begin in the next few months and hope you may be able to help. As I'm sure you can imagine transportation is a barrier for many individuals in the community. Especially those who live in rural parts of the community or have to travel across county lines for transportation. We are seeking volunteer drivers to help those in their communities who may not have access to a vehicle or public transit get to medical and non-medical appointments (groceries, employment, and other essential travel). We are looking for volunteers in the community who may be interested in helping to provide at least 2 rides per month. Volunteers will receive driving training as well as a mileage reimbursement for the trips made for the program. This pilot program will assist individuals who live in Mercer, Auglaize, Logan, Champaign, Shelby, Darke and Preble Counties, drivers however can live outside of those counties.

We are going to be having some virtual informational sessions for individuals to learn more or ask questions about this new program (Flyer attached).
