Greetings Parishioners,

We have exciting updates on the sanctuary restoration! Blanck Studios, the same company that is restoring our stained glass, submitted a beautiful proposal for repainting our sanctuary. They are very talented artists, and I'm sure will do an amazing job! The proposal was approved by Building and Grounds, Finance, and Parish Council.

The painting will take up to 3 weeks and is scheduled for July. It is much easier to do the painting before the rest of the renovation. They will restore and put new borders around the seven murals on the sanctuary walls. The murals are in great need of restoration. The capitals, currently a bronze color, will be painted gold will gold leaf highlights. The ceiling above the center of the sanctuary will be painted blue with gold stars. This conveys the reality that the Mass enables us to see into the glory of Heaven. It will draw our focus into the sanctuary and help to lift up our hearts as we pray. Many beautiful Gothic churches use this type of paint design. The ceiling of the rest of the church will not be painted at this time, but all the capitals in the church will be painted so they look consistent.
