Update on Statues

The new statues for the high altar and side altar niches have been ordered! They will be made by Santa Teresita, the same company that made our stations of the cross. They will be made out of fiberglass/resin, hand painted, and they will have glass eyes (which look more realistic than painted eyes). Because some of the statues will be custom made to the size we need, it will take a few months. We hope to have the statues in our sanctuary by the end of the year!
