Building and Grounds Update

Greetings parishioners! As many of you have noticed, we are in the process of tuck pointing the church. We will also tuck point the school and rectory this summer. The entire project could take around two months. Tuck pointing repairs damaged brick and mortar joints. The brick will then be sealed to prevent water from penetrating and damaging the bricks.

Tuck pointing has been a priority for the building and grounds committee for years, but we now have the finances to be able to do the project. I'm sure many of you have noticed damaged bricks on the church and pieces of crumbling bricks on the sidewalks around the church. Water has also been penetrating the building and damaging the plaster in a variety of places. Tuck pointing should take care of these issues.

Thank you to everyone who has donated to our building and grounds collections! By reducing other expenses at the parish, we have also been able to set aside \$1,000 per week from the regular Sunday collections for building and grounds. We have many projects ahead of us, but it is great to finally see the tuck pointing underway!
