

Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

This Thursday, August 15, is a Holy Day of Obligation. A Vigil Mass will be celebrated at SMOW at 7:00 PM on Wednesday, August 14. Mass for the Holy Day will be here at St. Patrick at 7:00 PM on Thursday.

We celebrate on this day Our Lady's entrance into heaven. At the end of her life, she was taken up, body and soul, into heavenly glory. In this way, she follows after her Son, who Ascended into heaven 40 days after Easter.

Simply speaking, death is the separation of our soul from our body. This is an unnatural state for us, because our nature is created as a body and soul union. Our souls, though they are eternal, await reunion with our bodies—something that will be accomplished at the end of time, in the resurrection of the body we profess in the Creed.

Our Lady's Assumption into heaven anticipates this moment for us. She already enjoys heavenly glory, and prays constantly for us that we would come to spend eternity by her side.

Be sure to come to Mass next Thursday, to thank her for her prayers, and to allow her to draw us closer to her Son than we would ever be without her help!
