The Four Last Things

The Four Last Things: Death (Part One)

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) teaches about death in sections 1006-1014. This is a brief summary of the first part of this teaching.

God created us not to die. Human death is a consequence of the original sin of our first parents. It is contrary to God's original plans.

The human body dies but the human soul lives on.

Because bodily death is the end of earthly life, it should lend a sense of urgency to our lives.

"Remembering our mortality helps us realize that we have a limited amount of time to bring our lives to fulfillment," i.e. in conformity with God's will in order to prepare us for death and judgment.

"Death is the end of man's earthly pilgrimage, of the time of grace and mercy which God offers him so as to work out his earthly life in keeping with the divine plan, and to decide his ultimate destiny."

Our ultimate destiny is either heaven or hell.

Next time we will see how the atoning death of Jesus Christ and his resurrection have transformed death into something positive.

St. Stephen of Hungary

August 16

Stephen; as the first Christian king of Hungary he united and Christianized the Magyar people; received the "holy crown" from Pope Sylvester II in 1000; renowned for his charity to beggars; known as the "Apostolic King and Apostle of Hungary."
