A new season of That Man Is You is starting up on Saturday September 11, 2021. This year's topic is "The Vision of Man Fully Alive" which enables men to experience authentic freedom as sons of God.

As men live the three-fold mission of abiding presence, joyful service, and loving sacrifice, their hearts and homes will experience the joy that God desires. To sustain them on their spiritual journey, the men will be led directly to the three spiritual foods that Christ himself proclaims:
