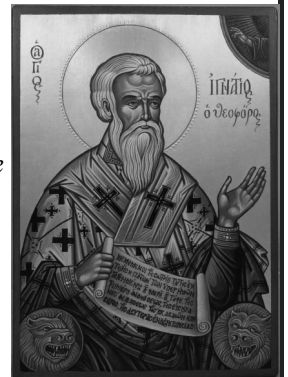

## St. Ignatius of Antioch, Bishop, Martyr

October 17

*Ignatius, c. +1-7 under Trajan in Rome’s amphitheater; from Syria; Apostolic Father known as the second successor of St. Peter in Antioch; wrote seven letters to local communities on church unity and structure, esp., the monoespiscopacy; first to use the term “Catholic Church” as a collective designation for Christians; mentioned in the Roman Canon.*
