The Easiest Way to Pray With Scripture

The Easiest Way to Pray With Scripture

Sometimes, one little thing can make everything better.

A good night's sleep is like that. If you sleep well, everything else is better including your work, your relationships and your mood. In that way, scripture is kind of like a good night's sleep.

Reading scripture makes everything else in life better. When you are close to it, it seeps into your thoughts and actions. It bestows wisdom and grants peace. It inspires trust and calms fears. Praying with scripture isn't just one good thing you can do, it's one good thing that will make everything else better. But how do you get started?
