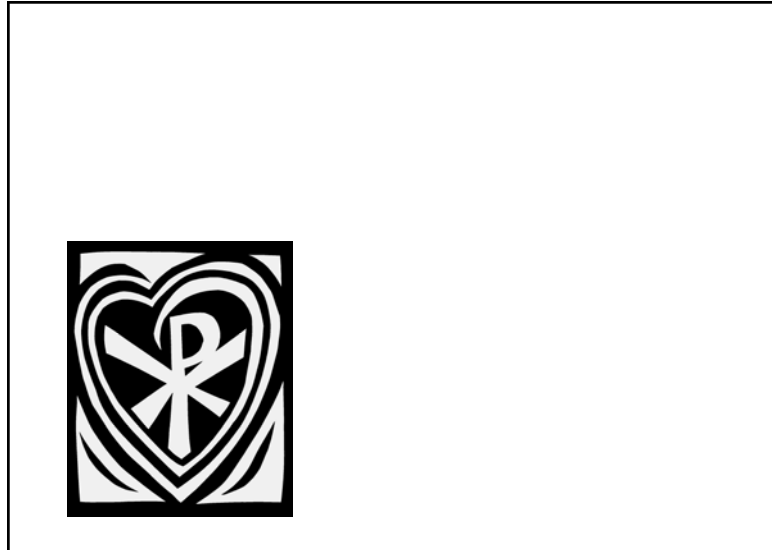

Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time – 30 October 2016 We are surely no thieves. When Jesus asked to come to his house, Zacchaeus pledged to give half of what he owned to the poor. Half! And then he did more. This thief, this extortionist promised to return at a four-fold rate all that he stole. Giving away what is not mine is an act of justice. Giving away what is mine is an act of mercy.

- What do I have in my possession that belongs to another? What surplus do I have that I can give away?
- What shall I give away that another needs?

All Saints – Tuesday, 01 November 2016 Look to the Saints. Saints walked the earth – just like us. They struggled to be good – just like us. Were loved by God, Saint John says – just like us. Lived the beatitudes, the blessed attitudes, the new law given by Jesus in varied ways – just like us. And right at the heart, exactly in the middle, the fifth of nine “blessed” is: Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.
