High Altar Update

This month we will be completing a major phase in the restoration of St. Patrick Church! The high altar and side altars will be installed this November. The current altar will sit in front of the high altar platform; it will remain in use for regular Masses.

Ornate high altars were developed to foster deeper reverence and devotion towards the Eucharist. Many parishioners have told me how the new painting in the sanctuary draws their attention and focus towards the Mass. A high altar also helps to draw our attention and focus towards the Eucharist. The Catechism, par. 1183, teaches: "The tabernacle is to be situated 'in churches in a most worthy place with the greatest hon-<u>or</u>.' The dignity, placing, and security of the Eucharistic tabernacle should foster adoration before the Lord really present in the Blessed Sacrament of the altar." The tabernacle/high altar should be the most beautifully decorated place in the church.

The high altar set was built in the 1880's, so it comes from the same historical era as our church (1897) and it was made in the same architectural style. Some parishioners have asked if there is room for the high altar. The high altar is almost the same size as our original high altar, so our sanctuary was designed for a high altar like this. I look forward to seeing these beautiful pieces in our church, and more importantly to their impact in deepening the Eucharistic devotion in our parish!
