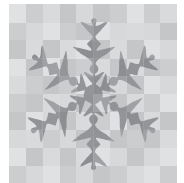
Formed.org Parish Subscription

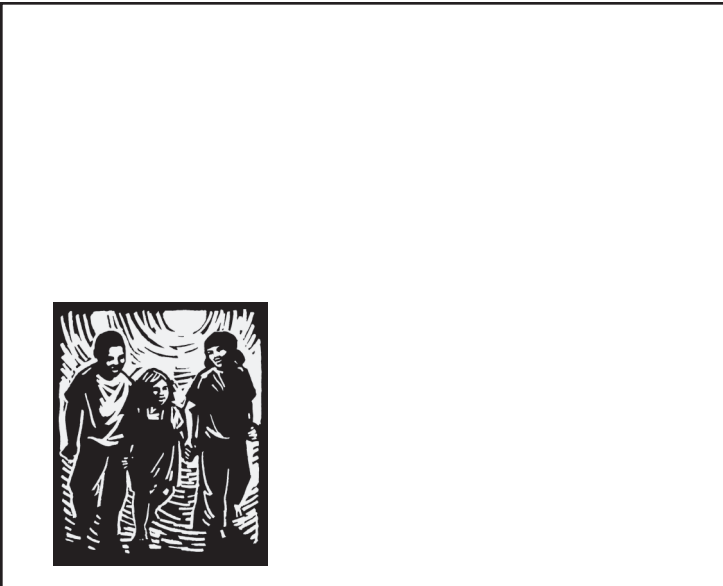
