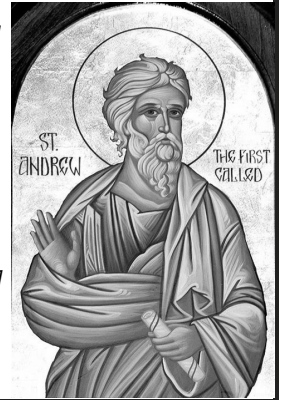

St. Andrew, Apostle

November 30

Andrew, +1st c.; brother of Simon Peter and disciple of John the Baptist; tradition holds he preached north of the Black Sea and in Greece, and died bound to an X-shaped cross, at Patras, Greece; patron of Russia and Scotland; as "Protoclete" or "First Called" (see Jn 1:40); patron of the Greek Church; patron of fishing industry; mentioned in the Roman Canon.
