HOLY WEEK AT SAINT PATRICK:

Saturday, March 24 @ 4 p.m. A smaller amount of Palms will be blessed in the Cry Room area prior to the start of Mass. You may bring your old blessed palms to place in the container to be burnt for next year's Ash Wednesday.

SUNDAY, MARCH 25 The Passion of our Lord at 10:00 A.M. The blessing of the palms will take place in MAKLEY HALL. You'll go to church first and pick up a Breaking Bread book. After the blessing and readings, with songs all will process over to the Church. The Mass will then start. Those unable to go to the hall will be able to hear the blessing and readings In church.

Holy Thursday of the Lord's Supper, March 29th, will start at 7:00 p.m. Fr. Larry Gearhart will be the celebrant. 12 men are needed to have their feet washed. After Holy Communion of the Most Blessed Sacrament, there will be a procession to MAKLEY Hall to take the Most Blessed Sacrament to the Tabernacle there. There is no consecration of the Body and Blood of Christ again until at the Easter Vigil. In MAKLEY HALL, Adoration will take place until 11:00 p.m.

GOOD FRIDAY of the Lord's Passion will take place at 2:30 p.m. this year. Fr, Emmanuel Nyong is the celebrant. There are three parts: the Readings, the Adoration of the Cross, and the most Blessed Sacrament that was consecrated at the Holy Thursday Mass. All may stay and pray or leave the church in silence.

The parish will decorate our beautiful church on Saturday morning, March 31st at 9:00 a.m. It will take about 90 minutes. Donuts, water and coffee will be served.

The Easter Vigil will be celebrated at 9:00 p.m. with Fr. Shawn Landenwitch as the celebrant on March 31st. It is the most important liturgy of the year in the Roman Catholic Church. Please join us.

Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord is April 1st at 10:00 a.m. with Fr. Shawn Landenwitch as the celebrant. Come early as we will be blessed with an overflowing church.

Divine Mercy is Sunday, April 8th.

First Communion is April 15 th at 10:00 A.M
