*Pyx: A Pyx is a small, round, usually gold-colored container for the consecrated hosts. The clergy or extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion use them when taking the Blessed Sacrament to those unable to attend Mass. Sometimes they bring the pyx up when receiving Holy Communion at Mass so the minister can put the needed number of hosts in it. Then they can make their visits right after Mass. At other times they get the hosts out of the tabernacle before making their visits.*
