The Angelus

The traditional prayer is a reflection on the incarnation with an emphasis on the Annunciation and Mary's affirmative reply to the angel. The recitation of the angelus includes three iterations of the Hail Mary. Traditionally bells were rung at 6 am, 12 noon, and 6 pm to signal that it was time for this prayer. It also would have indicated to the workers in the fields that it was time for lunch or dinner. During the Easter season it is usually replaced by the Regina Coeli (Queen of Heaven, rejoice, alleluia). The emphasis in this latter hymn is on the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.
