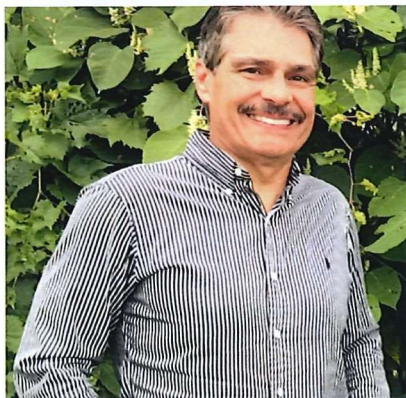

PASTORAL COUNCIL SUMMARY:

Parish Council met Tuesday, May 21st at 7:00 p.m. in the St. Joseph Room at SMOW with 10 of the 12 members present. Fr. Shawn led us in opening prayer and there were no parishioners present to address the council.

After submission of many records and documents to the Archdiocese, the Champaign County churches have been tentatively approved to form a Canonical Union under one tax ID number. Final approval should come in July from the Presbyteral Council of the Archdiocese. Logan County has been approved to remain a separate entity from Champaign County and our path forward will continue to be discussed at Parish Pastoral Council meetings.

Father Lindle's going-away party (family picnic) is planned for June 30 at 1:00 p.m. in the West Liberty Lyon's Park. Planning is ongoing and this will be a fun event for all.

Sursum Corda (Lift Up Your Hearts) – Father Shawn is starting this outreach for families with young children (Newborn-First Communion). The goal is to help parents build a stronger faith and prayer life, while learning to navigate through all the outside distractions. This could have a high potential for new Evangelization by attracting families outside the Catholic church that are looking for help dealing with our crazy world.

Restroom renovation options are being studied for the Holy Family Hall at SMOW to improve flow and handicap accessibility, as well as construction of a new restroom between St. Patrick Church and the rectory. Both items garnered a lot of discussion. Father Shawn is also concerned that the air conditioning in St. Mary of the Woods Church is not operating correctly, and the age of the boilers and lack of spare parts could also be problematic. Timmerman HVAC is looking into options for both.

Father gave us his blessing and the meeting concluded at 8:30 p.m. The next meeting will be July 23, 2024, in Makley Hall at St. Pat's. The meeting starts at 7:00 p.m.
