 Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity.**
 These Scripture verses relate part of a dialogue that Jesus was having with a Pharisee named Nicodemus. Nicodemus "came at night" (verse 2) and wondered if God was indeed "with" Jesus, based on the signs and miracles that he had heard about. Jesus advises the man that belief in the Son of God is the basis for being saved. Conversely, unbelief in the Son of God results in a judgment against that person. The conversation ends with Jesus' teaching rather than Nicodemus' conversion. (Celebrating Sunday for Catholic Families 2016-17)
