





MEET FATHER JARRED KOHN

My name is Fr. Jarred Kohn, and I am very excited to be joining the Mary, Queen of Angels Family of Parishes come July. I was born in Coldwater, Ohio and while I would eventually graduate from Coldwater High School in 2008, I spent the vast majority of my childhood – leading up to entering seminary – living outside of Philothea (a small town in between Coldwater and St. Henry). 
