






# DESIGN CONTEST FOR NEW OUR LADY OF FATIMA SHRINE

The American Society of Ephesus ("ASE"), in cooperation with ArtSpace/Lima, has announced that its state-wide Design Competition for the new Our Lady of Fatima Shrine at Indian Lake will start accepting entries on Saturday, June 15, 2024. The Entry Form and Rules are posted on the websites for ASE and for ArtSpace/Lima. The due date for submission of all entries is August 15, 2024. There are six age categories for artists: 10 and under, 12 and under, 14 and under, 16 and under, 18 and under and over 18. All Artists must be Ohio residents, as outlined in the Rules. There are cash prizes for the winning entries in all age categories of \$1,000.00 for the first five age categories and up to \$5,000.00 for the winning entry in the over 18 Age Category. # PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION JUNE 30, 2023

Parishioner contributions to the Peter's Pence collection help fund not only all the activities of the dicasteries of the Roman Curia that assist the pope in the exercise of his ministry but also a number of solidarity projects that aid those most in need. These works benefit our brothers and sisters on the margins of society, including victims of war, oppression and disaster.

Please take this opportunity to join with Pope Francis and be a sign of mercy to our suffering brothers and sisters.
