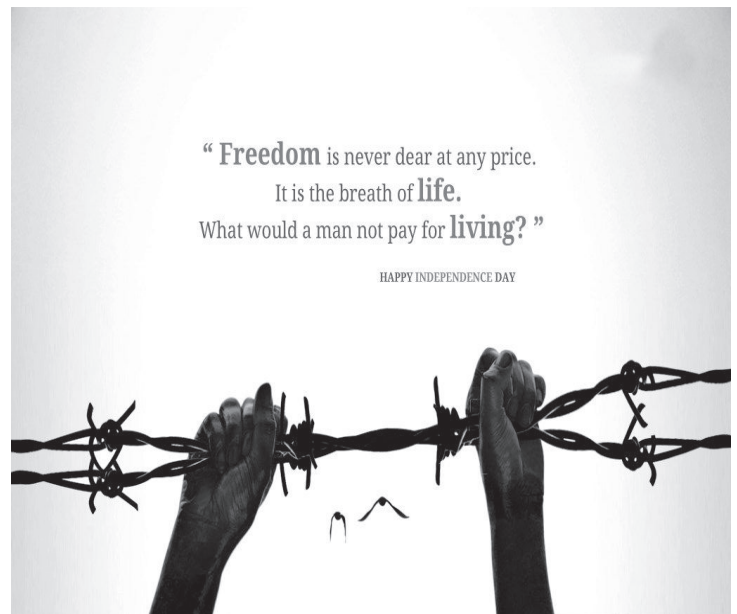
Patriotic Message
