Jesus explains that even our enemies- the people we hate or resent- deserves to be treated with the same care we want offered to us. Think about how Jesus paid attention to the sinners, the powerless, the out-cast, and the ignored. He forgave those who crucified him. How many times recently have you helped someone you don't know, or don't like? Do you notice people who are different, those ignored in the school hallways or in the lunchroom? When Jesus says to do this, it's a tall order. It takes time to learn how to love enemies.
