FROM THE DESK OF FATHER SHAWN...

St. Michael Prayer

At the September Parish Council meeting, a parishioner requested that we say the prayer to St. Michael the Archangel at the end of our Masses. The request received unanimous support from the council members at the meeting. We have a stained glass window on the west side of the Church that depicts St. Michael, so I think it is fitting that we pray for his intercession.

On October 13, 1884, Pope Leo XIII had a vision as he celebrated Mass in his private chapel. He stood motionless for 10 minutes. By one account, he overheard a conversation between Jesus and Satan. Satan asked for one century in all of human history to have greater power to carry out his evil work, and ultimately to destroy the Church. He chose the 20th Century. Immediately after Mass, Pope Leo XIII composed the prayer to St. Michael the Archangel to defend the faithful from the power of Satan and his kingdom.

The Prayer to St. Michael was recited at the end of Masses throughout the world from that time until 1970. Most parishes stopped praying the prayer with the liturgical changes that year. Pope John Paul II in 1994 urged Catholics to pray that prayer again. As we see the power of evil at work inside the Church and throughout the world, it seems fitting that we turn to the powerful intercession of Saint Michael to protect our Church, our families, and our world.

Restoration Update

I have received countless positive comments about our new Stations of the Cross. Some parishioners were even on the verge of tears when they saw the Stations for the 1st time. Thank you to everyone who donated; this is a gift that will enhance the beauty of our church for generations to come!

The high altar set that we purchased has been sanded, stained, and has a new polyurethane finish. Before we can put the set in the sanctuary, we need to build a platform for the high altar and put in new flooring. That work is scheduled to begin November 5th. It will take 1-2 weeks to complete. The original pine floor is in poor condition, so Parish Council voted unanimously to put in a new oak floor. The carpet will remain in the main body of the church, but the floor from the sanctuary step forward will be white oak.

We are also getting quotes on 2 pedestals that will sit next to the side altars. We plan to put the Mary and Joseph statues on these pedestals so they will be back in the sanctuary. We will then return the Sacred Heart statue to its position in front of the votive candles.

I truly believe this restoration work will help to foster deeper devotion to the Eucharist and draw us deeper into the beauty of God. This is an exciting time in the history of our parish!
