From the Desk of Father Shawn...**4th Degree Knights of Columbus**

The Knights of Columbus from St. Patrick and Saint Mary of the Woods (and surrounding parishes) are in the process of establishing a 4th Degree Assembly. The 4th Degree of the Knights of Columbus was established at a time when there was heavy anti-Catholicism in the United States. Groups like the KKK, American Protective Association, and the Know Nothing Movement spread anti-Catholicism. There were attempts to strip Catholics of the right to vote and opportunities for employment. Catholics were accused of plotting to bring the United States under the political control of the Pope. In response, the Knights of Columbus founded the 4th Degree as the Patriotic Degree. They encourage patriotism and active citizenship.

Today, every 4th Degree Assembly chooses a charitable mission to serve within the community. The 4th Degree provides the Honor Guard at public events and special liturgies. I'm sure many of us have seen the Knights dressed in uniform at processions, Confirmations, or other major events.

The Knights of Columbus are active in supporting seminarians, families, and the pro-life movement. They have provided almost 1,000 ultrasound machines (costing tens of thousands of dollars each) to pregnancy centers since 2009 as a way to support and defend life. Knights of Columbus are active on a local and national level. Every Catholic man aged 18+ should consider serving the Church as a member of the Knights of Columbus.
